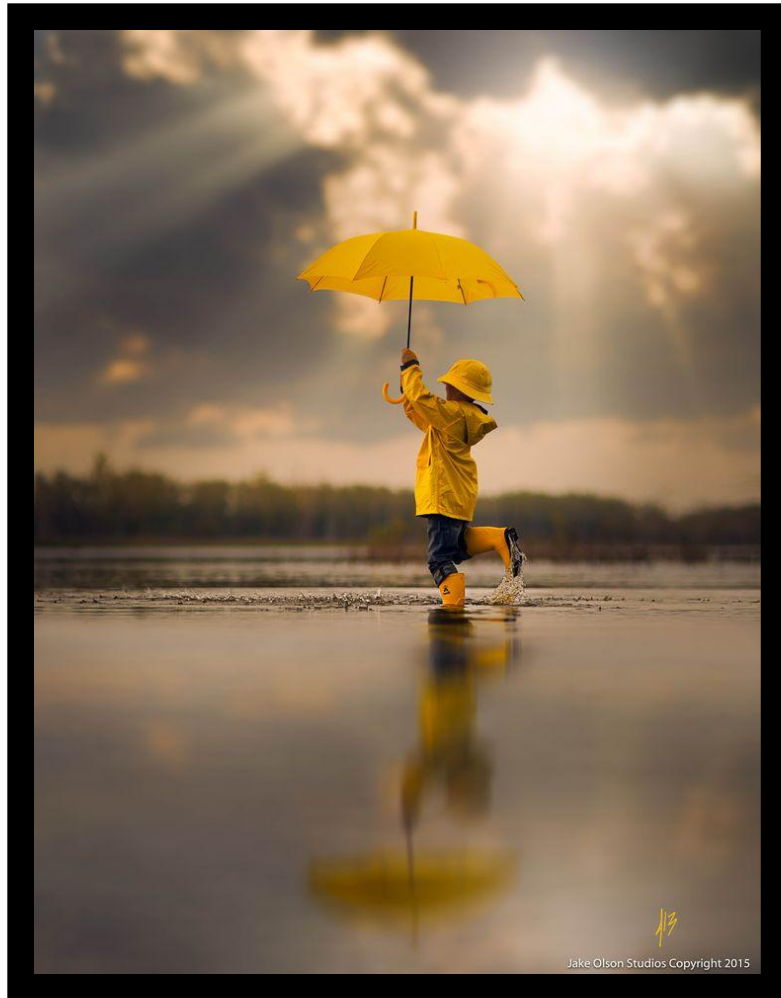

without any assurance of being alive the next morning,

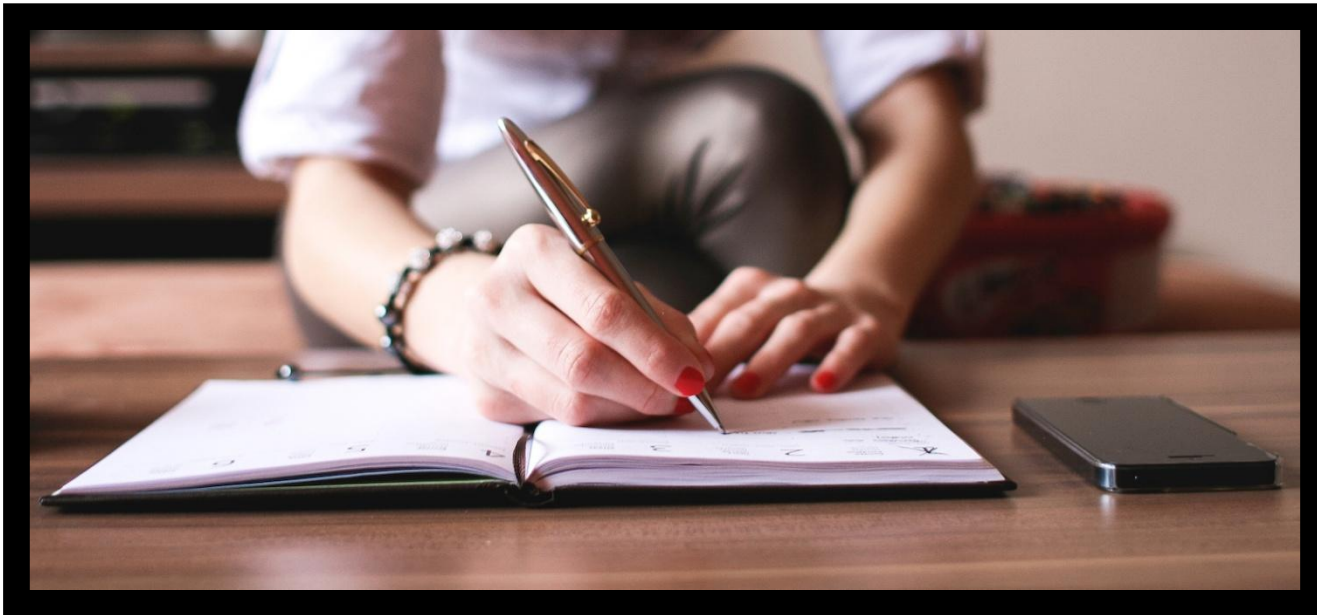
but still we set the alarms to wake up.
